 - Knowledge of the Canadian Language Benchmarks and their application

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Deliver Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC) to learners of varying levels, prepare materials, classroom and lesson plans as required.
 2. Be equipped with employment-focussed English Language Learning materials and activities to implement in classes of varying CLB's
 3. Whenever possible, collaborate with LINC Instructors in the development and implementation of instructional activities.
 4. Use computers, audio-visual aids and other equipment and materials to supplement instruction.
 5. Deliver lessons through a learner-centred approach that encourages active participation and engagement.
 6. Inform the Site Coordinator of all occurrences or facts that are necessary for an understanding of matters affecting the program or the people involved.
