 - Positive approach to using technology in the classroom
 - Knowledge of the Canadian Language Benchmarks and CLB: ESL for ALL and their application

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Deliver Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC) to learners of varying levels, prepare materials, classroom, and lesson plans as required.
 2. Deliver classes in varying formats (online, HyFlex, in-person) using technology and LMS
 3. Be equipped with employment-focused English language learning materials and activities to implement in classes of varying CLBs.
 4. Whenever possible, collaborate with LINC Instructors in the development and implementation of instructional activities.
 5. Use computers, audio-visual aids, and other equipment and materials to supplement instruction.
 6. Deliver lessons through a learner-centred approach that encourages active participation and engagement.
 7. Inform the Manager of Language Instruction Programs of all occurrences or facts that are necessary for an understanding of matters affecting the program or the people involved.
